


COVID-19与烟草使用

COVID-19 是什么?

COVID-19 是由一种冠状病毒引起的肺部疾病。¹ 当被感染的人咳嗽或打喷嚏且飞沫落在附近其他人的嘴或鼻子中时,病毒就会传播。²

COVID-19与商业烟草使用



商业烟草的使用会影响健康,导致肺部 受伤害等疾病。已经患有肺部疾病的吸烟 者特別容易被 COVID-19感染。³ 使用电 子烟也会导致肺部疾病康复的时间拖得更 長。⁴

与吸烟者生活在一起的家人,吸入二手烟的风险就更大了。 二手烟会导致严重的疾病,例如肺癌、哮喘和心脏病。⁵
